
CÓRDOBA - ARGENTINA



16,530,000 hectare total surface

89% has productive capacity (agriculture and livestock)

Given its size, it is the fifth largest province in the country.



ARTICULATION

Córdoba presents policies that can increase the value of agricultural production with the contribution of scientific and technological innovations.

The Ministry of Bioindustry and the Ministry of Production, Science and Technological Innovation analyze and systematize the range of policies and actions that allow improving the conditions for the development of agroindustry and the scientific-technical complex at the provincial area.

This proposal covers all productive food and agroindustrial chains based on natural resources.

It also aims to make these actions compatible with the National Government and enhance economic and agro-industrial growth through value chains for the promotion of productive clusters.

PRIMARY SECTOR



89% of its territory can be used for agriculture and livestock breeding.



Agricultural production: Córdoba is the 1st producer and national exporter of peanut, 2nd wheat producer, 1st national corn producer, 2nd national soybean producer, 1st national sorghum producer.



Livestock production: Córdoba is the 2nd national pig rodeo, 1st dairy producer (more than the production of Uruguay, Paraguay and Bolivia combined) and 3rd national apicultural producer.



The average production in recent years was 20 million tons of corn, 14 million tons of soybeans, 3 million tons of wheat, 1 million tons of peanuts, and 900 thousand tons of sorghum.



Taking into account sunflowers and legumes, Cordoba's agricultural production is 40

INDUSTRIAL SECTOR

The huge production of raw material is complemented by its industrialization. In the eastern and southern region of Córdoba, there are big factories and hundreds of small and medium-sized companies that process milk to produce dairy products.

In Cordoba, there are meat processing plants, some of which not only sell their products in the domestic market but also export the food produced.

Córdoba is the first world producer of candies and the sixth world producer of ice cream.

Also, Córdoba manufactures 35% of the country's total production of agricultural machineries and components, mainly in the southeast of the province, where the heart of the agricultural production region is set.

INDUSTRIAL SECTOR

The 30% of the total automotive national production is made in Córdoba. In the province, diverse automotive companies are set, such as Fiat, Renault, Volkswagen, Iveco and Nissan.

In the software industry, activity registers growth year after year, with more than 300 companies in the sector, employing more than 15,000 people and placing their products in more than 15 countries, being the USA the main destination.

In the equipment and medical supplies sector, Córdoba leads production. There was a reconversion process of some companies that tradicionally provide the automotive market – auto parts to supply the health segment.
